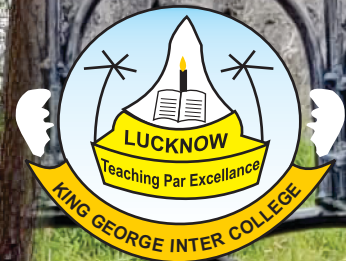

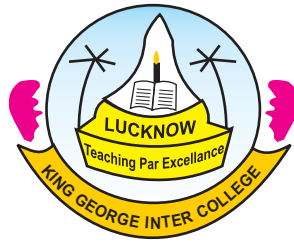

The Formative Pre-primary years:

At KGIC all efforts are made to make learning a pleasure in formative years of childhood. We have adopted the Montessori Method of pre-school education and have appointed nursery trained teachers for the pre-primary classes.

The Montessori Method aims at learning by doing. It awakens the child's interest and imagination in a systematic and graded manner. Our activities for the day have been designed and graded to suit the ability and interest of children of different age groups. It has a combination of activities such as sand play, water play, co-operative games, nature corner, a special activity room, ball pool, mini zoo, dramatics, music and dance and art / craft. Besides, toddlers are taught through the Montessori method

in a carefully prepared environment that stimulates and nurtures the mental and physical capacities of the "absorbent minds" as Maria Montessori referred to this precious age in a child's life as the most critical in the development process.

Education is a continuous and creative process. Its aim is to develop the capacities latent in human nature and to co-ordinate their expression for the enrichment and progress of society, King George Inter College does this by equipping children with spiritual, moral, intellectual and emotional capabilities. COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS

STUDENT'S FACILITIES

SCHOOL TRANSPORT:

The school provides transport to the students. A fleet of buses shall carry the students to and from the school. Rickshaws shall be provided on certain routes where the bus cannot ply. The Bus/Rickshaw facility once taken cannot be withdrawn.

LIBRARY:

Facilities of a well equipped library with books on various subjects, encyclopedia and periodicals are available for higher classes.

PICTURE READING:

In the pre-primary and primary classes, picture reading and storytelling from a regular feature of instruction.

LABORATORY:

Laboratory facilities are available for physics, chemistry and biology. The computer lab provides an adequate number of computers to impart computer education from Class I onwards.

PLAY GROUND:

A large and spacious playground is available with facilities for football, cricket badminton etc.

AUDIO VISUAL TEACHING:

T.V. & Video/other visual equipments are also available to screen educational and socially relevant programmes for the children.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES:

Mini zoo and aquarium for encouraging the activity of small students. The college has well equipped labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer for experimental work of Science.

REMEDIAL CLASSES:

Students weak in studies are given remedial coaching, either during activity period or zero periods.

PERSONALIZED COUNSELING:

PARENTS TEACHER & SOCIAL CO-ORDINATION

The Unique Bond:


To be successful in its efforts, the school and home co-ordinate, communicate, plan and help each other in creating a conducive environment both at home and at the school to enthuse and motivate the child to become both good and smart.

In order to bridge the gap between school and home, King George Inter College has unique provision which includes:

Parental Co-operation

- 
1. Parents are requested to look into their child's school diary everyday and see that the lesson and homework assigned for the next day are done regularly.
 2. All the notice and the remarks made in the diary should be countersigned regularly by the parents.
 3. If you feel that your child is not making the desired progress please make it a point to discuss it with the class teacher in PT M. meeting.
 4. If an interaction with the teacher is desired, it must be arranged by prior appointment and with the permission of the Principal.
 5. Private tuitions are not organized. Parents are requested not to arrange the teachers of the college as private tutors for their ward
 6. Rs. 5/- per day will be charged as fine for absenting from class without permission of Principal.
 7. All belongings of students should bear their name and class. College will not be responsible for any loss.
 8. Parents are requested to inform the school of any change of address.
 9. Please ensure that your ward takes part in all the activities of school.
 10. Parents are required to send their child to school on time. If three notices for late coming are found in the diary of the child, he/she will be told to go home from school in between classes.
 11. Children will not be allowed to go home from school in between classes.
 12. College periodically organises parent teachers meeting, where talks are arranged on child education and welfare. Attendance of at least one of the parents at such meetings is desirable.
 13. Parents should not take their child out of School without prior permission of the Principal during school days.
 14. No sick child will be sent to school with medicine between School Hours.
 15. Criticism of student, teacher or his school in the presence of the child should be avoided because it may cause the student to lose respect for his/her teacher and the School.
 16. a) Parents are required to send their children to school on time.
b) Presence of every child in the assembly is compulsory.
c) The child who fails to reach the school on time and does not attend the assembly may be sent back home.
d) The child turns out to school in proper uniform.
e) All the books & copies of the children are well covered and labeled throughout the session.
f) Children must bring books as per the time table.
 17. Please ensure that your ward takes part in all the activities of the School.

CHANGE OF RULES

Rules and regulations mentioned herein may be changed without any prior notice. Any modifications, as and when made, will be binding on all existing students.

PARENT - TEACHER MEETINGS

The school periodically organises parent - teacher meetings where talks are arranged on child education and child welfare. Attendance of at least one of the parents such meeting is desirable. Sports, games and education and child welfare. Attendance of the parent at such meetings is desirable. Sports, games and physical fitness activities are an integral part of KGIC education. KGIC student have been regularly winning top honors in Bhartiyaam, physical fitness activities. Without solid physical fitness activities and sports programme, this achievement would have been highly unlikely. King George Inter College has adopted the American co-operative games which emphasize and develop the spirit of cooperation as against that of competition. The co-operative games are taught regularly to KGIC teachers and students.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ADMISSION

1. Application for admission should be made to the Principal on the prescribed form. The Principal reserves the right, without specifying any reason whatsoever for refusing admission to an applicant.
2. Admission to Pre-primary classes is made according to the age of the child 2-3 year for Pre-Nursery; 4 years for Nursery and above 5 years for Kindergarten. Also a child's ability will be taken into consideration.
3. Admission to any class except pre-primary is made after a pre-admission test and on submission of a valid transfer certificate from the previous institution.

ATTENDANCE, ABSENCE, FINE AND RE-ADMISSION FEE.

1. As regular attendance is an important requirement for successful result, a written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the guardian should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible. A minimum attendance of 90% of the total working days is required during the academic year, falling short of which the student will not be allowed to appear in the examination that year. The name of a student shall be struck.
2. Re-admission fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged from the student who is continuously absent for 15 days without any information/leave application. Rs. 5/- per day will be charged as "absence fine" in addition to the re-admission fee.
3. A student whose name has been struck off absence without leave and who is habitually late or persistently careless or indisciplined may not be re-admitted to the School.
4. Every student must be present on the reopening day after each vacation.
5. It is advised to parents/guardians to ensure that a student is not disturbed during examination days and is not asked to attend family functions, No re-exam will be taken.
6. No student can leave the school premise during school hours without the written permission of the Principal, which may be granted under exceptional circumstance, based on a written request of parents.
7. The Principal has the right to suspend a student. The Principal may also ask parents/guardians to withdraw their child from the school if his/her conduct or educational progress is not satisfactory.
8. All entries of absence, late-coming or half-day leave should be made in the school diary and not on sheets of paper.

GENERAL RULES

1. Students of all classes should attend assembly in the morning. Late comers may not be allowed to enter class without the Principal's permission.
2. Parents or their servant are not allowed to enter any classroom during study periods. No servant is allowed to be in the school premise till home time.
3. No child will be absent without a Written leave application. In case of contagious disease, the child will not be allowed to attend school without a fitness certificate from an authorized medical practitioner.
4. No jewelry is to be worn (except a wrist watch) and not make-up of any kind is to be used. Nails are to be kept trimmed.
5. The school does not accept responsibility for loss of books, money, clothes and other items belonging to the student. Each child is responsible for his/her own belongings.
6. Any kind of damage done to school property or premises by a student is to be made by him/her. Student should keep their bicycles properly locked in the school cycle stand. School authorities will not be responsible for any loss of unlocked cycles kept in the cycle stand.
7. Every child is urged to contribute to the values and standards of the School by his/her conduct, discipline and commitment to studies.
8. It is compulsory for student to participate in school functions, sports, cultural and literary activities for at least one function per year the child will have to get a dress or a costume made, as desired by the Principal.
9. No child will be allowed to leave school during school hours. In exceptional case, the child be allowed to go with the permission of the Principal and accompanied by parents only.
10. Parent's cooperation is solicited in maintaining punctuality, regularity and discipline at all school functions.

RULES AND REGULATION FOR STUDENTS

1. Student should study hard and try to secure at least 80% marks in each and every subject in all the test in examination. However, the minimum pass percentage, which students must secure in every subject and paper is 60%.
2. If your child is detained in class IX and XI in annual examination, no request for promotion or re-examination will be entertained.
3. A minimum of 80% attendance is compulsory in the school.
4. Every student must attend special or extra classes whenever he/she is required to attend such classes.
5. The name of any student may be struck off the rolls on account of indiscipline, cheating in examination or frequent absence from the school.
6. Parents are also requested to pay special attention to the studies of their children if they are weak in any subject.
7. It is compulsory to obtain the prescribed council prospects and syllabus.
8. Any objectionable thing found with the child will be strictly dealt with strictness.
9. All fee dues and fines should be cleared before the Annual examination.
10. Attending Parents/Teacher/Principal parents meeting is compulsory.
11. Kindly treat home phone calls by teacher as a matter of importance.
12. Attendance for school function is compulsory.

Every act of teacher is to infuse a spirit of excellence, emotional development, harmony, co-operation, character building and discipline in every pupil.

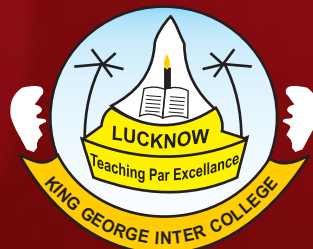
